- more technic

- Harder to get jobs
- Organised training and sports
- Youth organizations
- Entertainment and social media

Leisure time - Austria

Earlier generations:

- more religious organisations
- countryside: more work
- Outdoor activities

Present youth:

- part-time jobs
- organised sports
- Social Media (Instagram, Facebook,...)
- Meeting friends (cinema, concerts, cafes)
- High pressure: on good education
