# European Union

## Norway:

Not a part of the EU :

- EÖS - access to the free market
- “Net til EU”
- Agriculture
- Fishing



## Austria :

In the European Union :

- Common currency that facilitates tourist travel, trade, ... between countries.
- Free movement of people. Trade facilitated.
- Peace between the countries of the Union.
- Reduced gsm roaming rate.



# Public/private sector

## Norway:

- Employed: 2 591 902, 31,79% (823 883) in the public sector, 68,21% (1 768 019) in the private sector (2016)
- Public sector slightly increasing
- Welfare state: free school, health insurance, social rights
  - Taxes, oil, fish → rich country → public sector
  - Public sector gives safer jobs

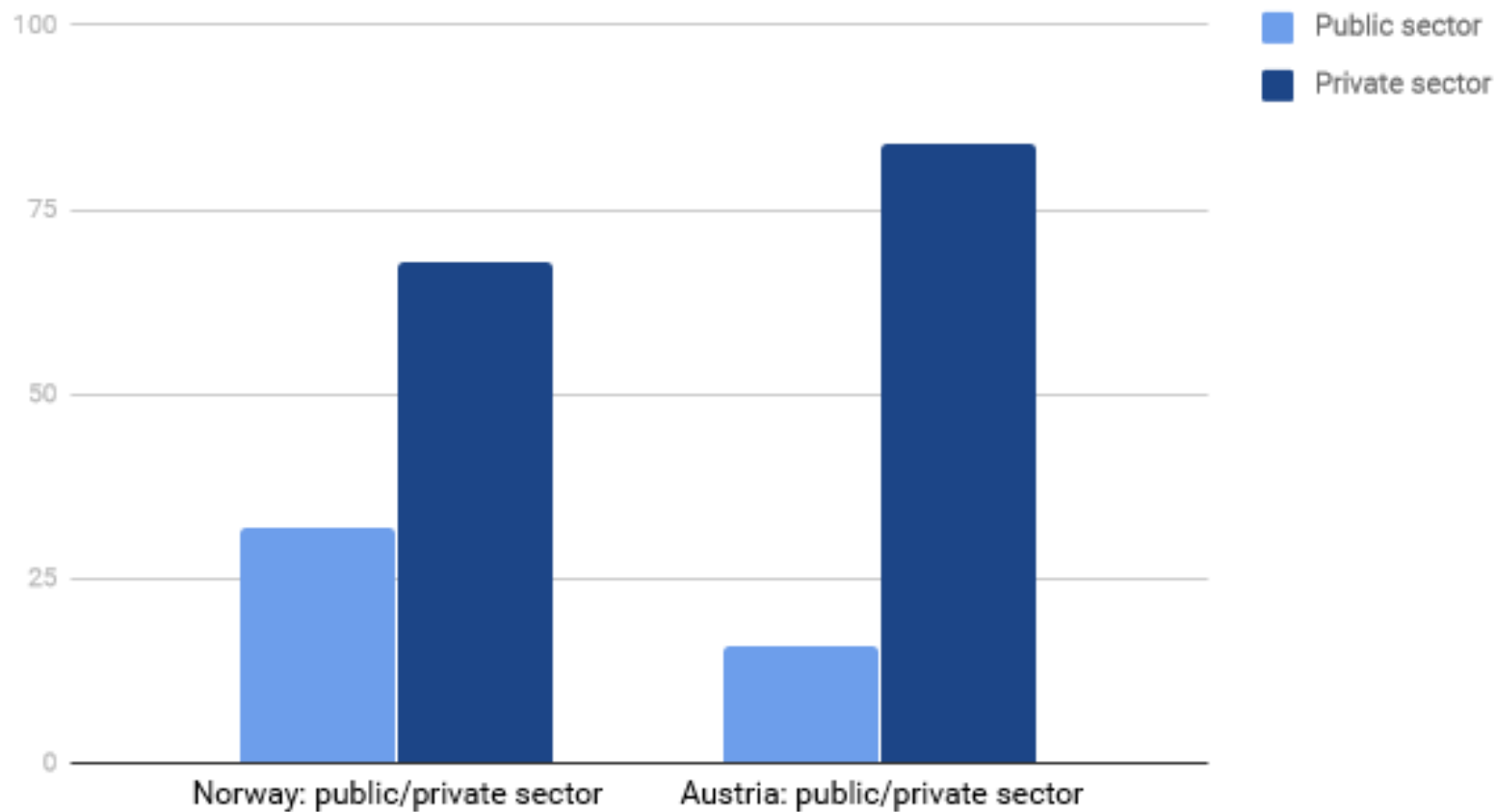


## Austria :

- Employed: 4.167.164, 16% (666.746) in the public sector, 84% (3.500.418) in the private sector (2015)
- Private sector is increasing
- Welfare state: free school, health insurance

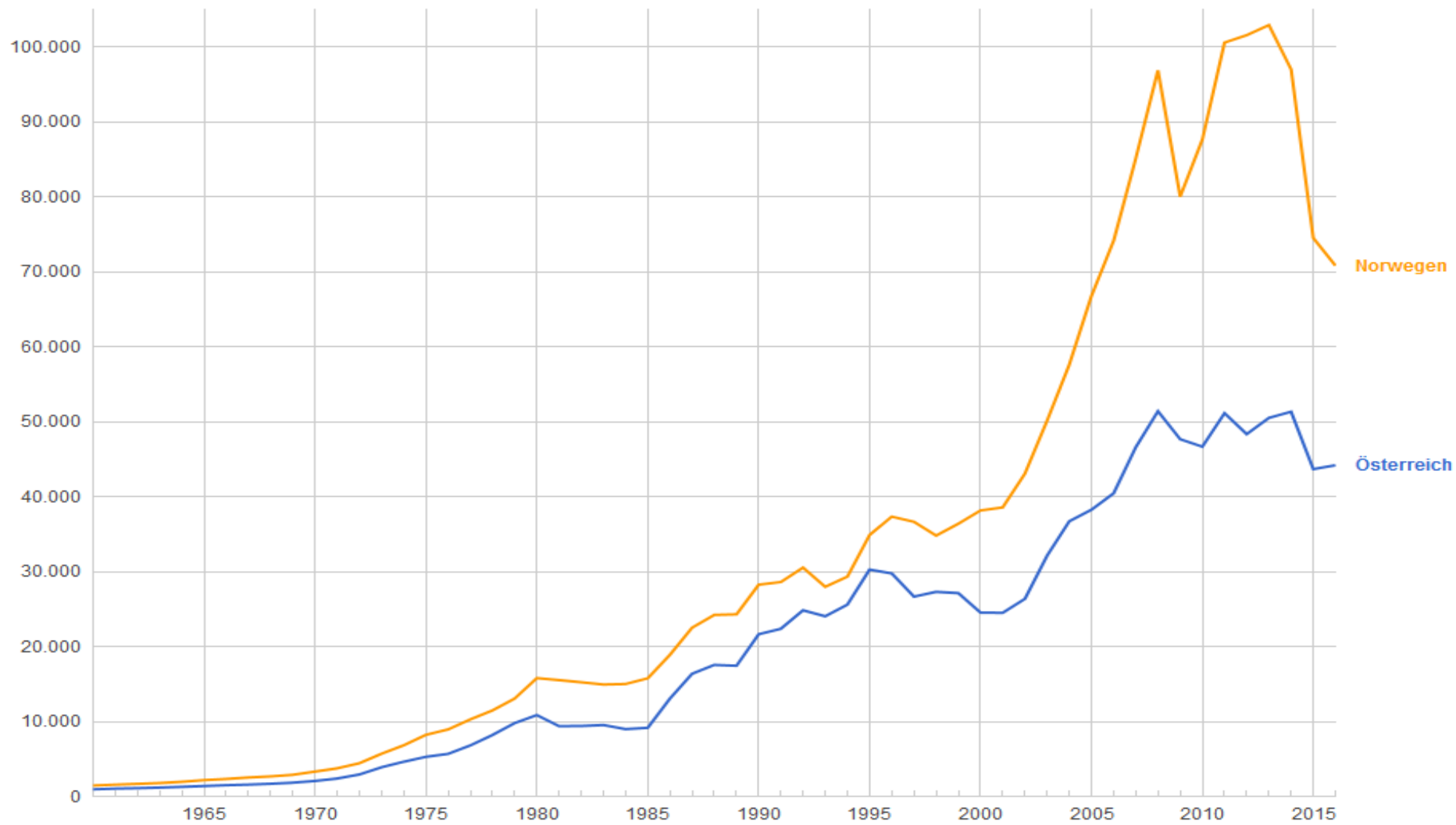
## Norway:
